<b>Mission Belles Attendance Award</b>	Given at fall and winter regional meetings based on number of chorus members attending and distance driven to the event. <b>Memorial Board</b>	Recognizes all R10 members who have transferred to the "Heavenly Chorus" in the past year with a bio and photograph on a display board at regional contest. The information is also added to a notebook for the Regional Historian.	<b>Deadline: February 20</b> Application forms are made available at the Winter Regional and distributed via email to presidents/team coordinators. <b>The Nancy K Carter Community Harmony Award</b>	Presented annually to the chorus with the greatest number of non-paid public performances between February 1-January 31. Monetary award and certificate presented at regional contest. Certificates of merit also presented to all chapters with at least one non-paid performance in that year.	<b>Deadline: February 20</b> Application emailed to presidents/team coordinators in December  Contact: Marsha Bock
<b>Region 10 Membership Growth Award</b>	Presented annually to the chorus with the greatest net percentage gain in the region from February 15-February 14. Monetary award and certificate presented at regional contest. Certificates of merit also presented to all choruses that post a net membership gain in that year.	<b>Deadline: February 20</b> Application emailed to presidents/team coordinators in December  Contact: Marsha Bock

<b>Marketing Award</b>	At the beginning of each fiscal year, a list of marketing-related activities is published on the Resources page of the Regional website. Choruses must accomplish a minimum number of the activities to qualify for the award. The Chorus PR/Marketing Manager submits notes and examples of qualifications by deadline.	<b>Deadline: One month prior to Regional Contest</b> Awards distributed during the Show of Champions at regional contest. <b>Wall of Fame</b>	Each chapter selects a member to be honored at contest weekend (own criteria).
