The NANCY K Carter Community Harmony Award	Presented annually to the chorus with the greatest number of non-paid public performances from February 1-January 31. Monetary award and certificate presented at regional contest. Certificates of merit also presented to all chapters with at least one non- paid performance in that year. Mission Belles Attendance Award	Given at all regional meetings based on number of chorus members attending and distance driven to the event. Award includes engraved 'traveling plaque' and front-row seating at regional events. Memorial Board	Recognizes all R10 members who have transferred to the "Heavenly Chorus" in the past year with a bio and photograph on a display board at regional contest. The information is also added to a notebook for the Regional Historian. Region 10 Membership Growth Award	Presented annually to the chorus with the greatest net percentage gain in the region from February 15-February 14. Monetary award and certificate presented at regional contest. Certificates of merit also presented to all choruses that post a net membership gain in that year. Wall of Fame	Each chapter selects a member to be honored at contest weekend (own criteria). Honorees are displayed on Wall of Fame Boards on easels in the hotel atrium.	Deadline: Wednesday, Contest Week Envelope distributed to president/team coordinator at Winter Regional Contact: Karen Bernard
Scrapbook Contest	Chorus historians prepare 1 or 2 scrapbook pages covering the previous year. Pages are displayed on tables in the hotel atrium.	Deadline: Competition Friday Envelope distributed to president/team coordinator at Winter Regional. Contact: Karen Bernard
