- Cell phones and other electronic devices should be turned off or set to silent. No pictures or videos from your cell phones are allowed. Please, no vibrating/buzzing/anything else that might distract competitors and audience members alike.
- While a contestant is on stage (quartet or chorus), please do not illuminate your smartphone or tablet for any reason. Your cell phone is brighter — and much more distracting — than you think. Facebook, Twitter, Instagram, work, and your kids back home can wait until we're between competitors.
- We only close the doors when a competitor is ready to enter the stage. If the doors are closed, please do not try to open or rattle them.
- When the doors close, please take the nearest available seat. It's ok if you are not sitting with your friends for one contestant.
- No excess noise of any sort or kind (including babies/children) during a contestant's performances.
- No photography or video recording is allowed during any contestant's performance except by the official photographer – and that is NOT you. REPEATED FOR EMPHASIS.

If any of these rules are violated, the CRC and CC have the right to request immediate removal of said equipment or persons from contest(s) until after contest(s) are completed.
